## **Suggested Answers**

The bundle is relatively simple and it could contain three collections: *browse, data,* and *document*. The bundle could have multiple data collection, for example, collections for atmosphere and ring data.

Bundle LID: urn:nasa:pds:uranus\_occ\_saao\_1.88m

## **Collection LIDs**

Browse: urn:nasa:pds:uranus\_occ\_saao\_1.88m:browse

Data: urn:nasa:pds:uranus\_occ\_saao\_1.88m:data

Document: urn:nasa:pds:uranus\_occ\_saao\_1.88m:document

Scheme for basic products LIDs: urn:nasa:pds:<bundle\_id>:<collection\_id>:<file\_name>
